

## Jeff Andrews and Studio M Lighting Illuminate the 2026 Grammy Awards with a Warm, Intimate Glow

Los Angeles, CA — Studio M Lighting partnered with celebrity interior designer Jeff Andrews on a bespoke lighting collaboration for the 2026 Grammy Awards, introducing warmth and intimacy to a global cultural stage. Designed specifically for the ceremony, the petite rechargeable table lamps played a critical yet understated role shaping how guests experienced the space throughout the evening.

Conceived by Jeff Andrews ([www.jeffandrewsdesign.com](http://www.jeffandrewsdesign.com)) and realized by Studio M ([www.studiomlighting.com](http://www.studiomlighting.com)), the lamps feature a solid brass body paired with an opaque glass shade, carefully proportioned to diffuse light softly and evenly across each table surface. The resulting glow is warm, controlled, and deliberately restrained to enhance conversation, presence, and atmosphere without distraction. In a venue defined by scale and spectacle, the lighting introduced moments of human closeness and visual calm.

Grammys Executive Producer Raj Kapoor said, *“When looking to elevate our Grammy nominee area, we wanted to have a bespoke lamp that complimented our VIP tables. The first person I thought of was Jeff Andrews. I knew he would design the perfect piece for this special evening of global television. Not only did it need to function as a beautiful architectural statement with high-end craftsmanship, but it also needed to cast a beautiful glow on all the amazing talent we have in our room. We were absolutely thrilled with the outcome.”*

Installed throughout the venue at Los Angeles’s Crypto.com Arena, the lamps illuminated the dining tables where nominees, performers, presenters, and guests gathered ahead of and during the ceremony. Their quiet consistency across the space helped unify the environment, complementing the Grammys’ bold golden stage design while grounding the overall experience in material richness and intention.

*“Lighting is about feeling as much as form,”* said Jeff Andrews. *“These lamps were designed to bring warmth and focus—to create a sense of intimacy within the very large, beautifully conceived environment designed by Yellow Studio.”*

For Studio M Lighting, the collaboration reflected a shared design sensibility rooted in craftsmanship, proportion, and emotional resonance. Working closely with Andrews, Studio M brought its artisan approach to a purpose-designed lamp that balanced performance and beauty—pairing cordless functionality with refined materiality and a timeless silhouette.

The project revealed a shared design sensibility and an ease of collaboration that naturally lends itself to continued creative exploration.
